### **Options and Enrollment Counseling**

Staff meet with individuals and their support network to discuss his/her long-term care needs and the available services to meeting those needs;

Staff explain publicly-funded, longterm care options and determine functional and financial eligibility, so individuals can make an informed decision.



### **Youth Transition**



Staff assist students to transition from the school system by coordinating with parents/guardians as well as educational and vocational groups, and help make the right connects to resources that promote independence and inclusion.

### **Disability Benefits Specialist**

DBS staff help individuals with disabilities access public and private benefits. Working with a Disability Rights Wisconsin attorney, staff help the individual obtain and retain benefits.



### **Go Pass**

In partnership with the Department on Aging and the Milwaukee County Transit System, individuals with a disability, or over the age of 65, may qualify for significantly discounted fares on MCTS busses.
